Employment law is always evolving. The multitude of rules, statutes and litigation ensures a perpetual stream of decisions that can impact cases you are handling now. In addition, social media and evolving electronic devices provide readily available and very public forums for employees and employers to air their differences, and what they tweet or say on Facebook often turns up in litigation. Ten years ago, tweeting was something only the birds did. Four years ago, tinder was simply wood used for a fire. What's new now, will be old 5 years from now. It's essential for employment lawyers to keep up. NELA's annual conference, cosponsored by the NJ ICLE, takes a look at what is "trending now" in the field of employment law and brings you up to date on the most recent developments in the field.

She collaborates with social scientists on empirical research to identify the efficacy of interventions to address implicit bias and racial anxiety. She regularly provides trainings and lectures to a wide range of private and public institutions seeking to address the role of bias and anxiety associated with race, ethnicity, religion, and gender and provided trainings on implicit bias to state judges across the country on behalf of the National Association of State Judges.
